Did or does your mom preach any one-line sermons? I ran across these examples of one-line sermons.

MOM'S ONE-LINE SERMONS

In John 2:5, at the wedding in Cana, Mary, mother of Jesus, tells the servants, "Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it." That's "Mary's One-Line Sermon." Now, my mom preached some great one-line sermons to me as I was growing up. She had a one-line sermon from Revelation 19, about the coming judgment: "Wait till your father comes home!" She had a one-line sermon from Luke 2, about the nativity: Every time I left the front door open she would ask, "Were you born in a barn?" She had a one-line sermon from Matthew 28, on international missions: "There are children starving in India!" She had a one-line sermon from Isaiah 53:5, about the substitutionary atonement: "This is going to hurt me more than it hurts you." She had a one-line sermon from Luke 16, about Lazarus and the rich man: "You want your allowance, and people in Hell want ice water."

Well, since I'm not a mother, that's about all I have for you as my "Mother's Day Message." I can say though unequivocally that I have the best mother in the whole world. I learned about Jesus at her feet. She led me to Jesus, talked about Him, lived for Him and still does at the young age of 82.

Do you know the difference between "Father's Day" and "Mother's Day?" May I suggest this young man may have it right?

FATHER'S DAY VS. MOTHER'S DAY One little boy's definition of Father's Day went like this: "Well, it's just like Mother's Day, only you don't spend so much." Well, we fathers can concede that. Someone said, "A father is someone who carries pictures where his money used to be." And the phone company tells us that calls on Father's Day are not as high in number as calls on Mother's Day, and most of them are collect.

I do hope all mothers from PSBC and you our dear guest, that you have a great "Mother's Day. "
